9. FILMING AND DOCUMENTARY VISA APPLICATION PROCESS

A citizen of a foreign country, who wishes to go to Turkey for the purpose of movie and documentary shooting should obtain a permit from the Ministry of Culture and Tourism, Directorate General of Cinema and the provincial Governorate. After having the permit, crew members can apply for a filming and documentary visa at the nearest Turkish mission to their residence.

Application Method:

- 1. Obtain your permit from <u>Directorate General of Cinema</u> of the Ministry of Culture and Tourism, and the provincial Governorate.
- 2. Assemble the required documents listed below.
- 3. Start an online application on <u>www.visa.gov.tr</u> and upload the documents when prompted.
- 4. Print out the application form. (*Requirement #2*)
- 5. After submitting the application successfully, schedule an appointment for the interview.

Applicants are required to bring hard copies of the documents on the day of the interview as well.

- Screenshots will not be accepted. Documents are requested in their original size.
- The documents such as travel insurance, flight and hotel reservations must contain the name and surname of the applicant.

Required documents:

- 1. National passport and copy of the front page with photo.
 - a) with an expiration date at least 60 days beyond the last day of your intended stay.
 - b) with a blank page to affix the visa.
- 2. The application form
- 3. One recent passport photo size (2" x 2")
- 4. Employment letter or last 6 months bank account statements

a) If you are being sponsored, a letter describing the sponsorship must be submitted.

- 5. Hotel and flight reservations (These reservations do not need to be purchased yet)
 - a) A notarized invitation letter is required if you are going to be hosted.
- 6. Official permission letter (permit)
- 7. Original and the copy of your green card or your valid US visa. (for NON-US applicants only)
 - Valid I-20 or the letter from school is required for the student visa holders.
 - B1/B2 visa holders can only apply at their country of residence.
- 8. Proof of travel health/accident insurance, valid through duration of stay, including:
 - a) minimum coverage of 30,000 Euros or equivalent USD

b) transfer of the patient to nearest healthcare facility or residency address after discharge and transfer of body in case of death,

- 9. Non-refundable visa fee
 - Visa fees can only be paid in cash or as money order payable to Turkish Consulate General in NY. Debit, credit and personal checks are not accepted.
 - Single entry visa fee: 185.00 USD for US citizens
 - **Multiple entry visa fee: 265.00 USD** for US citizens (*valid only for 6 months with a 90-day stay*)
 - You may e-mail us to find out the visa fee for non-US citizens.

Important notes:

- Visa processing may take up to 30 days after the interview. Please do not finalize your travel arrangements until you are notified about the outcome of your visa application.
- Your visa can have 90-day stay max. If needed, you must apply for a residence permit on https://e-ikamet.goc.gov.tr which will allow you to stay beyond that period.
- In individual cases, you may be required to provide additional documents.
