Reference: RFP Professional Commissioning Services, dated October 11, 2017

Based on questions submitted by the firms regarding the bid security, I kindly request from bidding firms to take into account the following information;

1. A 10% Bid Bond or bank Letter of Credit Bid Security as per RFP Item 8.5, page 12, is **NOT** required to accompany the proposal.
2. However as stated in Article 12.8.1 of the Draft Agreement and Article 8.5 of the RFP, prior to the execution of the aforementioned Agreement, a letter of credit in an amount equal to six percent (6%) of the Agreement Price (the "**Letter of Credit**") must be provided by Commissioning Consultant to Contracting Entity as financial and performance security. The Letter of Credit shall be issued by a bank reasonably acceptable to Contracting Entity.

Bidders will submit their proposal in a sealed envelope as defined and noted in the RFP at 9:00:00 am EDT, Monday October 30, 2017 to the following address:
